

Information for the 37th Annual Rhino Ag Dirt Track World Championship presented by Optima Batteries, October 19th, 20th & 21st at Portsmouth Raceway Park.

GENERAL

- Portsmouth Raceway Park does not accept credit/debit cards at the gates or concessions. There is no ATM on site. Only cash will be accepted. Please plan accordingly.
- You will receive ONE armband for the entire event. Do NOT take it off. If you lose it, you will have to purchase another one.

CAMPING

- Camping Registration begins Sunday, October 15th at 12:00 p.m. and will be open daily at 9:00 a.m. If you arrive after Camping Registration is closed, please park on the large concrete pad. You will have to register the following morning and be taken to your campsite.
- Primitive camping is \$40 for the week/weekend of the DTWC.
- Please print the Camping Agreement and have it filled out to make Camping Registration run smoothly.
- ATVs and UTVs are NOT permitted in the campground. Golf carts only in the campground.
- Speed limit is 5 MPH in the campground and parking lot, KEEP IT SLOW.
- Parents are responsible for the whereabouts, safety and conduct of their children at all times.
- Each camper is responsible for daily clean-up and care of camping area. Garbage bags can be picked up at the main concession stand. Place trash in plastic bags in front of your camp site (daily pick up is at 9:00 a.m.)
- Pets are welcome in the campground ONLY and must be kept on a leash and kept quiet.
- All persons entering the campground do so at their own risk.
- All vehicles and RV's entering the grounds must be insured.
- Management is not responsible for damage, injury or loss to either person or property.
- Please keep fires contained. You MUST use a fire ring if you have a campfire. Fire rings are not provided.
- All campers must stop at Camping Registration located on the concrete boat ramp. Someone will show you where to park.
- If you pre-paid for a campsite, please bring your receipt to Camping Registration.
- Absolutely no refunds due to weather. No Exceptions.
- Little's Septic Tank Service will be at the track all week for those needing holding tanks emptied. They will be circling throughout the grounds. If you need to contact them, their number is 740-574-2033.
- If you are in need of water, please call Bill Pick at 740-858-2436 for delivery.
- Firewood and ice can be purchased at the track.

PARKING

- Vehicle parking is free. Handicap parking is available near the General Admission gate.
- A shuttle will run through the parking and camping areas to give rides to/from the gates.

GATES

- General Admission and Pit Gates open at 2:00 p.m. on Thursday, Friday, and Saturday.
- EACH DAY GROUNDS WILL BE CLEARED AND SECURED AT 1:00 p.m. AND REOPENED AT 2:00 p.m. Please plan accordingly so that gates may be opened as scheduled.

SEATS

- Stadium seats are not to exceed 18 inches in maximum width in the bleachers. No high backs allowed. Please be considerate of those who are sitting around you. If you do not have room for your knees, then those behind you do not have.
- No lawn chairs allowed.
- Other than reserved seats (reserved seats are the top 10 rows on the front stretch), all seats are on a first come, first serve basis. You can mark off seats at your own risk, however, bleachers WILL BE

CLEARED EACH DAY BEFORE GATES OPEN. When gates open at 2:00 p.m., you will be permitted to put things down, but we are not responsible for anything left in the stands.

- Handicap Seating: We ask that the front row of the grandstands be left open for Handicap/Disabled persons.
- Personal propane heaters are prohibited in the grandstands.
- Smoking is prohibited in the grandstands.

COOLERS

- Only soft sided coolers (up to 12 inches) will be permitted in the grandstands.
- No alcohol is permitted inside the gates.
- No glass bottles are allowed.

ALCOHOL

- Alcohol is not sold at the track and cannot be brought inside the gates.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

- Announcements must be taken to the track office located behind the main grandstand.

- Make sure to bring your Photo ID and Receipt/email Confirmation (you can show the email on a phone if you cannot print)

- If you cannot find your email confirmation, please call Mindy at 740-858-6661 or email tickets@thedtwc.com to have one resent.

- The name on the receipt must match the Photo ID of the person picking up tickets.

- If someone besides the name on the receipt will be picking up tickets, please call ahead to let us know. 740-858-6661 (Mindy)

- If you purchased All Access Pit Passes, each person will need to come to the Will Call Window to sign the Pit Waiver form to get the armband. No pit armbands will be given out without a signature. Minor Forms will need to be completed for everyone under 18 getting a Pit Pass (even if one has already been completed at PRP in 2017).

- You will receive ONE armband for the entire event. Do NOT take it off. If you lose it you will have to purchase a new one.
